

Images - Resizing

How do I alter the size of my graphic?

Method One:

- Click the image to select it. Eight small circles called 'handles' will appear around it.
- 2. To alter: the width: Position your cursor over the middle left or middle right handle.



the height:

Position your cursor over the top middle or bottom middle handle.

both proportionately (recommended):

- Position your cursor over one of the corner handles.
- 3. Click and hold down the mouse button
- 4. Drag the cursor to the left or right to increase/decrease the width/height/both.

Method Two:

- 1. Click your image to select it.
- 2. Click to display the 'Picture Tools, Format' ribbon.
- 3. Use the 'Height' and 'Width' spin controls in the 'Size'
