What is the 'Internet'?

The Internet (or 'Net') is a worldwide group of computers connected in order to communicate with each other and share information. All computers at services are connected to the Internet either wired (connected via cables) or wireless.

Services have 'Net access for 2 main purposes;

1. Accessing BUSINESS related information on the web.
2. Sending and receiving BUSINESS email.

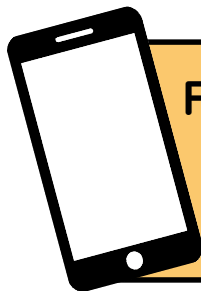
How do I view the information on the 'Web'?
